On behalf of my colleagues in Cabinet, I would like to congratulate everyone who has worked so diligently in making the Yukon Gazette a reality, and wish them continued success with the project in the future.

Introduction

Although the requisite growing pains have existed along the way, Yukon has progressed almost steadily since June 13, 1898, when it was officially designated as a distinct jurisdiction of Canada under the terms of the *Yukon Act*.



The Act also provided for a Territorial Government, consisting of a Commissioner and an appointed Council.

The first wholly-elected Council took office in 1909, and consisted of eleven Members. But this number has fluctuated over the years in accordance with population figures: today's Legislative Assembly is comprised of sixteen Members, representing each of Yukon's electoral districts.

Coupled with these continual advances, Yukon held its first election along party lines in the fall of November, 1978, with the Progressive Conservatives securing the majority of seats.

Up to and including that time, the actions of the governing Executive Committee were subject to the consent of the Commissioner, who was and still is, the federal government's senior public servant in Yukon.



However, in October, 1979, the terms of reference for the Commissioner were altered substantially by the federal Progressive Conservative government.

As a result of this, the Executive Committee was allowed to change its name to the Executive Council, or Cabinet, and authorized to make decisions on its own.

While the government of Yukon has always publicized its decisions, regulations, notices and other official matters, this information was relayed only through local newspapers and was not available for reference purposes in a formal manner.

Newspapers will still be utilized when the need arises, but the monthly compilation of government matters in this Gazette is clearly another step in the evolution of responsible government in Yukon.
