AREA DEVELOPMENT ACT

Carcross General Development Regulations, amendment

Pursuant to section 4 of the *Area Development Act*, the Commissioner in Executive Council is pleased hereby to make the following order.

Dated at Whitehorse, Yukon, this 13th day of August, 1985.

1. The zoning map in Schedule B of the Carcross General Development Regulations is hereby repealed, and the attached zoning map entitled 'Carcross Zoning Map' dated February 28, 1985, drawing No. MS-8-22, is substituted for it.
2. Section 24 of the Carcross General Development Regulations is further amended by inserting after "R-1 Residential; single family, two-family, Multifamily and Mobile Homes" the following new category; "R-2 Country Residential".
3. The Carcross General Development Regulations are further amended by the addition of the following new section after section 32:

"32.1 (1) In Zone R-2 Country Residential

- a) only one single family dwelling or mobile home is permitted on a lot;
- b) a business may be conducted on the lot, subject to the following conditions:
 - i) the business shall be conducted from within the dwelling,
 - ii) if the business is conducted from within the dwelling, not more than 25% of the total floor area may be used for the business,
 - iii) a business that is conducted from within the dwelling shall be conducted so as not to create a nuisance to the occupants of adjacent premises,
- c) the total floor area of all accessory buildings or structures shall not exceed the total floor area of the principle dwelling;
- d) a guest house is an accessory building and may be built on a lot larger than 1.0 ha, but the guest house shall have a floor area no larger than 45.0 m²;
- e) no building, or structure other than a fence or gate, may be built within 7.5 m of a lot boundary;
- f) no lot may be smaller than 0.5 ha, nor larger than 1.5 ha.;
- g) no building or structure shall exceed 2½ storeys or 12.0 m in height;
- h) Sufficient land shall be set aside for the parking of vehicles so that no vehicle need be parked on the street;
- i) Where animals or birds are kept on a lot,
 - i) they shall be restrained so as not to stray off the lot, and
 - ii) wastes shall be disposed of in compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations made under it.

4. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 36 of the Carcross General Development Regulations is repealed, and the following paragraph is inserted in its place:

"a) Permitted uses include health centres, hospitals, government buildings, fire halls, public utility buildings and structures, police stations, senior citizens homes, nursing homes, churches, necessary residential uses accessory to the principle use, and any other use that is of a similar nature."

"(2) In the area marked CR in Appendix A, the following provisions shall apply

- (a) the purpose of the CR zone is to facilitate quiet outdoor recreational use that, for its full enjoyment requires large area of substantially undisturbed land and to this end in a CR zone only the following development shall be permitted:
 - (i) outdoor recreational uses and activities not requiring much power, such as but not limited to camping, hiking, horse riding, pedal cycling, skiing, snow shoeing and swimming (this clause shall not be interpreted to prevent access to or egress from a campsite in a camping area designated by the proprietor by motor vehicle, nor shall it prevent the proprietor or his agent from using motor vehicles and other motor powered machinery for operating the camping area, carrying out maintenance, or constructing new facilities);
 - (ii) the construction and operation of cabin, motel or lodge type accommodation for use by travellers;
 - (iii) the retail sale of petroleum products and minor automotive accessories, and the construction of any structures necessary for this use;
 - (iv) buildings and structures accessory to the use and activities mentioned in subparagraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) such as cooking or other shelters, washhouses, barns, storage and workshop buildings, change houses and refreshment facilities, restaurant, and staff accommodation;
 - (v) one single-family dwelling for the use of a resident owner, operator or manager;
- (b) the minimum lot size shall be 30 ha, but for the purpose of this clause a lot may include one or more contiguous parcels of land, (including leased land and land subject to an agreement for sale) which are under the control of one person and which in the aggregate amount to at least the required minimum area."
