ORDER-IN-COUNCIL 1980/151

FOREST PROTECTION ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of the Forest Protection Ordinance, the Commissioner in Executive Council is pleased to and doth hereby order as follows:

C.O. 1972/159 is amended by changing the following sections:

Section 2	4 miles should now read 6 km
Section 2	10 miles should now read 16 km

C.O. 1959/34 is amended by changing the following sections:

Section 6	100 feet should now read 30 m
Section 8	200 feet should now read 60 m
Section 12	2 feet should now read 60 cm
Section 22(1) (a)	10 quart should now read 10 L
Section 22(1) (d)	7 1/8" x 10 1/2" should now read 20 cm x 25 cm
Section 22(1) (f)	40 gallons per minute at 100 lb. pressure and 200 lb. cut-off pressure should now read 180 L per minute at 690 kPa pressure and 1380 kPa cut-off pressure.
Section 22(2)	5 gal. should now read 20 L
Section 22(2)	1,000'-1 1/2" should now read 300 m-38 cm
Section 22(2)	2,500'-1 1/2" should now read 800 m-38 cm
